PENSIERO DOMENICALE

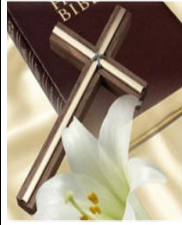

The Mass is the heart of our Catholicism.

The miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and the fish provides a chance for us to reflect on the Eucharist, on the Mass, and to appreciate that it is THE central action of Catholic life. It is our special place for spiritual nourishment, the source of our spiritual strength.

The suffering Jewish people, of whom Isaiah speaks, were offered God's strength for their journey from exile in Babylon. We too need strength and spiritual stamina to leave our own Babylons for the land of the Lord. For us it is called **conversion of life** and such journeys are never easy.

We are assisted when we celebrate the Mass, when we come to two tables that can make us stronger: the table of the WORD where we hear the saving truth of God read, preached and applied to our lives, and the table of the EUCHARIST, where we receive the Risen Christ and a real transfer of Christ's life and strength to us that we call GRACE.

Through our participation in the Mass, God's life grows within us and we gain spiritual strength from the Lord. Our presence reminds us that our life is not a private story but part of a much larger community of Faith, part of the story of the Body of Christ in our world.

If we become lost it is through the Mass that we can find our way home. That is why the Mass is at **the heart of our Catholicism.**
