Receiving EUCHARIST commits us to a particular way of life.

Today's Feast of *Corpus Christi*, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, takes us to the heart of what we do when we celebrate Eucharist. The words "*This is my Body ... This is my Blood*" have shaped the lives and devotion of people for centuries. Jesus' gift to the Church on the night before he died was the gift of his very own self under the form of bread and wine.

Sharing the body and blood of Christ is more than simply repeating what was done at the Last Supper. It gives us closer contact with Jesus because any distance between us vanishes. Receiving Holy Communion is more than a pious personal gesture. It is a public proclamation of our Faith and the reality of our communion with Christ and the Church. Many people refrain from this sacrament as they feel unworthy. But if we wait until we are really worthy, perhaps none of us would ever receive this great gift!

Our sharing the body and blood of Christ, commits us to a certain way of life, congruent with all that the Eucharist symbolises. It commits us to action, recognising & responding to those in need. As people of the Eucharist we must read the signs of our times that demand a practical Christian response.

Today we are challenged to examine our own lives: do they reflect the full significance of receiving Holy Communion? The Eucharist is the centre of the Church's life. **Is it central to mine as well?**
