What kind of soil am I?

The *Parable of the Sower* helps us to understand how and why God's Word, a word of life and salvation and power, a word that can heal, rescue and revive, gets such a mixed response. Many people fail to embrace or absorb the Word of God. Why? Because the seed which is scattered far and wide, can fall on the road, on rocky ground, among thorns, or in rich soil. The seed is all good; the difference lies in the ground where it falls.

On the pavement the Word fails to germinate. On rocks there is no place to take root and, amongst thorns, it is choked. In rich soil the seed, the message that Jesus gives us, flourishes and bears fruit in abundance. The message to us is to sow the best we can, to spread Christ's Word as effectively and honestly as we know how, and leave the rest to our **God of Surprises** who can produce amazing results!

Often, we are so preoccupied and frustrated by the seed that fails, we need this parable to remind us of the successes. All that we see in the Church, schools, religious orders, parishes, and the commitment of so many people to the work of the Gospel, are products of the seed taking root in good soil.

Sow widely and generously and there WILL BE a harvest!
