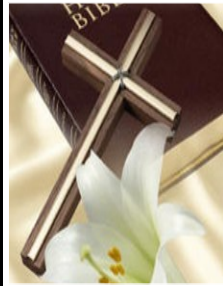

By God's grace there will be a harvest.

Last week Jesus spoke about seed, the message of Jesus, which fell on different kinds of soil. This represented the types of people who heard God's Word, some receptive, others deaf. Today's parable turns it around. Here the soil is the world (or the Church) and, in that soil, all kinds of things (and people) grow: wheat and weeds. The farmer had to let them grow together and separate them at harvest time.

This parable contains important truths about God, the Church and our world. God is a patient God, warning us along the journey, offering second chances, but ultimately we cannot escape his justice.

Our Church is a mixed bag, weeds and wheat. We must learn to cope with both because the Church is not a gallery of saints, but a school for the transformation of sinners.

Both wheat and weeds, grace and evil, exist in our world. They both grow and have power. But despite the weeds in every generation there is still a harvest of people doing good; knowing, loving and serving God. We must not be so distracted by weeds that we overlook God's grace which will produce a wonderful Resurrection harvest, despite the presence of numerous weeds.
