Hospitality is a characteristic of the Church Community

Jesus teaches us about the challenge of carrying our cross, and the gift of hospitality. He speaks of hospitality in terms of how his chosen Twelve, his Apostles & messengers, are treated.

Jesus' words about carrying the cross are very dramatic and distressing. He says that if we love our relatives more than we love him, we are not worthy of him. Such words must be understood in the context of those times and they fit comfortably in that early Church situation when the decision to move from Judaism, and become a Christian, tore families apart. Christianity was incompatible with everything around it, so becoming Christian was a momentous decision with serious consequences.

We live in a society that is hostile to the values of the Gospel and on almost every front we are faced with the decision to silently go along with everyone else or to live as Christ teaches. Many Catholics drift away from the truth and, having made mistakes, they feel that the Church doesn't want them anymore. But they don't have to be perfect and we gather here to become holy; we don't arrive in perfect shape! The hospitality of the Church is an experience of grace where people who don't have perfect lives can come to begin again.

There is room for everyone here; no one is excluded. The community Jesus founded cares for the wounded and this hospitality enables people to heal, to put their broken pieces back together. That's why weekly Mass is important for all of us.

It is the place where our burdens become lighter, more manageable, and possible to carry. The Church is a place to call home, where we can renew our spiritual strength and begin afresh; where we are always welcome and granted another chance.
