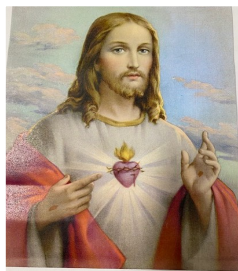

**The TRINITY is not a puzzle; it is a story of Love**

How comfortable are you with mystery? In today's society many are uncomfortable with mystery. They must know and be able to understand through logical steps of inquiry. We teach young people to think and we encourage them to question, but perhaps we don't teach them that it is okay to be comfortable with mystery. Humans can never fully understand everything!

Take the mystery of GOD, for example. Ours is a God of love, and we celebrate that in our focus on God as TRINITY. Many people want a safe God, a God who is neatly packaged up, because if God escapes we may be forced to face important questions and issues in our lives. God can seem useful only when our own efforts prove futile. Yet, even then, we prefer a God who follows our directions. Today, as we celebrate the Most Holy Trinity, it can be frightening because **the Trinity is ultimately a mystery and we are often uncomfortable with mystery!!** We can't control or fully understand the Trinity. Yet the mystery of the Trinity is not a problem to be solved, but a way of life to be experienced.

To say that God is love and to fully appreciate what that means, is to think of God as Trinity: the love of Father, Son and Spirit. It is this mystery of the Trinity in which we live, and move and have our being. Ultimately, the Trinity, rather than being a puzzle to be solved, **is a Story of LOVE.**

May we be comfortable today as we celebrate the mystery of God as Trinity; a God of love, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. It is this God who calls us to fruitful lives of love and service to each other.
