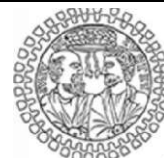

THIS WEEK'S GOSPEL REFLECTION

Matthew 15:21-28

A Faith That Would Not Give Up

In this Sunday's Gospel, a Canaanite woman approaches Jesus with a desperate plea: "Lord, help me." At first, Jesus seems to remain silent, and even when she continues to ask, His response appears challenging. Yet the woman does not walk away. She persists, trusting that Jesus will hear her.

Her remarkable faith reminds us that prayer is not always answered in the way or the timeframe we expect. There may be moments when God seems silent, when our prayers appear unanswered, or when we feel discouraged. The Canaanite woman teaches us to remain faithful and to keep turning towards Christ, even in those difficult moments. Jesus ultimately recognises her great faith and grants her request. Her story reminds us that genuine faith is not about having all the answers; it is about continuing to trust in God, even when the path is uncertain.

This week, may we bring our needs and those of our loved ones to the Lord with the same persistence and confidence, trusting in His mercy and never losing hope.
