TEACHING MEDITATION AND PRAYER

Catholic Theological College is running the online unit Teaching Meditation and Prayer over two Saturdays in June (**17 & 24 June**) and two Saturdays in October (**7 & 14 October**).

This unit offers an ideal opportunity for lay leaders and other interested people in your parish to develop skills in facilitating meditation and prayer within a parish context. The emphasis is on silent meditation and establishing places of silence in a contemporary context.

The unit may be undertaken as part of an undergraduate or postgraduate award (including the Graduate Certificate in Teaching Meditation), as a single unit for credit, or for personal enrichment (no assessment/credit). It forms part of the Graduate

Certificate in Teaching Meditation which is recognised by Meditation Australia.

Cost: is \$650 as an audit student (no assessment/credit)

Fees may be paid through FEE_HELP when units are part of a University of Divinity award.
