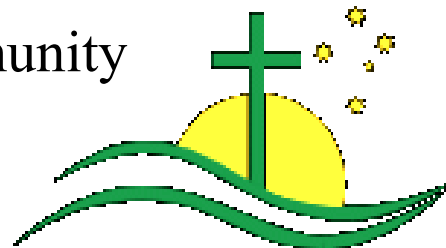

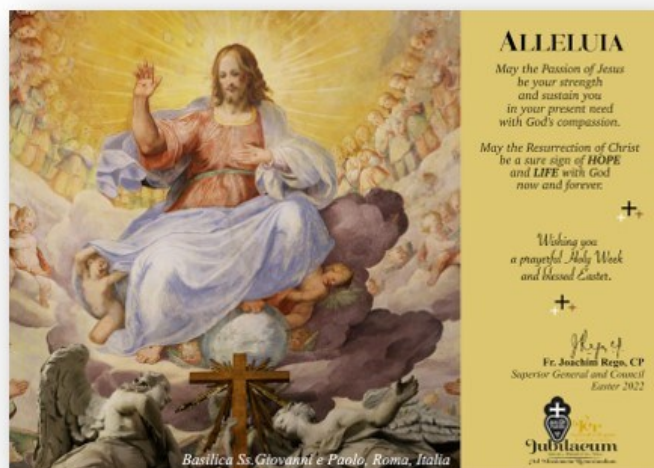

2022 Sacrament of First Communion program

Below are the dates for the program of Sacrament of First Communion at our Church. This program is designed for children in grade 4 to 6 (must have already received their Sacrament of Reconciliation)

Tuesday, 3 May - Introduction night in church 7pm
(follow by 4 classes in the schools & after school RE classes)

Tuesday, 26 July - Final class at church at 7pm

Masses are: Friday, 29 July at 7pm
or Saturday, 30 Jul at 12pm

If you wish to register your child into this program, please contact the Parish Office by Friday 15 April 2022. Cost is \$20per child.

After School Religious Education Program

All Children who are registered for this year's First Communion Program and do not attend a Parish School, are required to attend this class (in addition to attending family nights). It runs on **TUESDAYS from 4pm to 5pm** in the Church. Parents, or Guardians, are required to sign the child in on arrival and sign them out on departure.

Dates for this program are: **24 May, 14 June and 12 July**. Attendance on all dates is compulsory.
