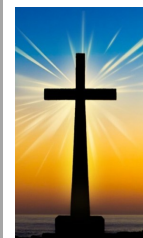

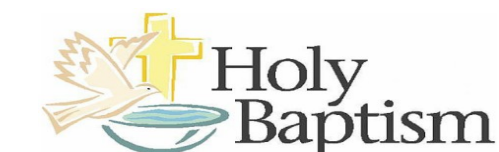

our parish, a navigator, traveller and visionary, who

*St Brendan the Navigator (c 484-c 577) Priest, Abbot,
founder of many Monasteries also known as "of Clonfert,"
"the Voyager," "the Anchorite" and "the Bold".
Patronages - boatmen, divers, mariners, sailor, travellers,
whales, portaging canoes, Diocese of Clonfer, Diocese of
Kerry.
He is primarily renowned for his legendary quest to the "Isle
of the Blessed", also called "Saint Brendan's Island".*

We give thanks to God for all who have contributed to the St Brendan's story, who have worked to build this
community of faith and who call St Brendan's home.

May this "Sailor of God" guide us always and inspire us as people of Good News.
