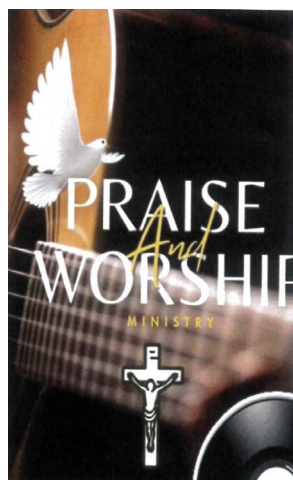

Volunteer Driver with car needed for Tuesdays nights - for The Kensington Neighbourhood House Community - BREAD BANK

The Bread Bank for Derby St Public Housing in Kensington is needing volunteers to help collect bread from Hadfield to Kensington.

Every Tuesday night they need a driver with a car to drive from Derby St Public Housing Tower with Catherine or Sue (Volunteers), to West St Cafe and Bakery in Hadfield.

The trip takes 20 to 30 minutes depending on traffic.

4 to 6 large bags of fresh bread and rolls is collected and driven back to Derby St.

We liaise with Security who set up a Trestle table for us in the Foyer at Kensington and we display the bread and rolls by type and leave a notice saying what day the bread was sourced.

Residents then collect bread and rolls and it helps enormously with the increase in food prices and the low centrelink allowances people try to survive on.

Volunteers are not paid for their time or petrol however they are welcome to take home fresh bread which is a really good quality.
