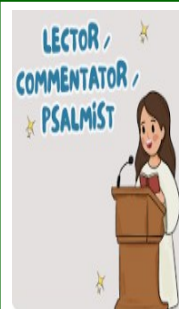

Volunteer Driver with car needed for Tuesdays nights - for The Kensington Neighbourhood House Community - BREAD BANK

The Bread Bank for Derby St Public Housing in **Kensington** is needing volunteers to help collect bread from Hadfield to
Kensington. Every Tuesday night we need a driver with a car to drive from Derby St Public Housing Tower with a Volunteers, to
West St Cafe and Bakery in Hadfield. The trip takes 20 to 30 minutes depending on traffic. 4 to 6 large bags of fresh bread and
rolls is collected and driven back to Derby St.

Security set up a Trestle table for us in the Foyer at Kensington and we display the bread & rolls by type and leave a notice
stating the day the bread was sourced.

Residents then collect bread & rolls, it helps enormously with the increase in food process.

Volunteers are not paid for their time or petrol however they are welcome to take home fresh bread which is a really good quality.
