A story of how your cash donations to Vinnies make a real difference

When you place cash in our St Vincent De Paul donation boxes, every coin and note comes directly to our Flemington Vinnies conference and we hand it directly back to the people we help – our Companions. The vouchers we give out for Woolworths, Big W, and Vinnies shops meet many needs, but sometimes people need more than these vouchers can provide. One lady we visited two years ago was sleeping in her car. We gave her Woollies and Vinnies vouchers. And we also gave her cash. It made all the difference, because she had no money for petrol. That small amount of cash kept her mobile and safe. Two years on, that same lady is now in her own safe home and is an NDIS support worker looking after a severely injured person. She also volunteers, cooking in a kitchen that serves meals for people experiencing homelessness. Your money didn't just help her through a crisis.

It helped her rebuild her life, and she is now making a difference to others.
