Something to Think About

Can you remember a time that you came together with your family for a celebration? What did you do together? How did it feel to have the love and support of your family around you?

The Story

In the gospel today, the disciples have locked themselves away in a room, paralysed by their fear. Jesus had died in an horrific way... they were afraid that his followers could expect similar treatment. The closed doors and locked-in fears were no barriers for Jesus. He entered the room, and their hearts, and brought them peace. He gave the disciples an important job to continue his mission when he said: 'I am sending you just as the Father has sent me'. Thomas was not with the others when Jesus appeared to them, and he refused to believe. Jesus appeared a second time, and Thomas was with them. He saw Jesus and believed. Jesus said that those who believe without seeing him are really blessed.

The Scriptures

A reading from the holy Gospel according to John (20:19-29)

The disciples were afraid of the Jewish leaders, and on the evening of that same Sunday they locked themselves in a room. Suddenly, Jesus appeared in the middle of the group. He greeted them and showed them his hands and his side. When the disciples saw the Lord, they became very happy.

After Jesus had greeted them again, he said, "I am sending you, just as the Father has sent me." Then he breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive anyone's sins, they will be forgiven. But if you don't forgive their sins, they will not be forgiven."

Although Thomas the Twin was one of the twelve disciples, he was not with the others when Jesus appeared to them. So they told him, "We have seen the Lord!" But Thomas said, "First, I must see the nail scars in his hands and touch them with my finger. I must put my hand where the spear went into his side. I won't believe unless I do this!"

A week later the disciples were together again. This time Thomas was with them. Jesus came in while the doors were still locked and stood in the middle of the group. He greeted his disciples and said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and look at my hands! Put your hand into my side. Stop doubting and have faith!"

Thomas replied, "You are my Lord and my God!" Jesus said, "Thomas, do you have faith because you have seen me? The people who have faith in me without seeing me are the ones who are really blessed!"

Group Discussion

Jesus took away the disciples' fear when they were afraid. Think of a time when you felt 'locked in' or afraid. Who supported you and helped to take away your fear? Jesus offers us that peace when we are afraid.

Reader 6: We pray for our own needs (*Invite the children to pray for their own special intentions*). Lord, hear us.

All: Lord, hear our prayer.

Leader: Loving God, listen to the prayers we make in the name of Jesus.

All: Amen.

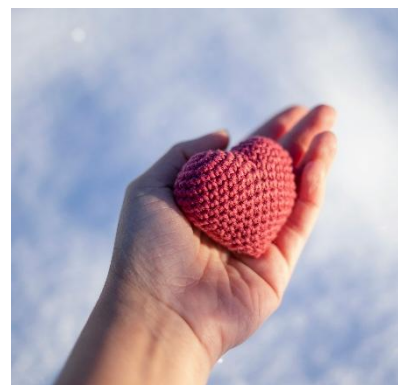


Group Activity (optional)

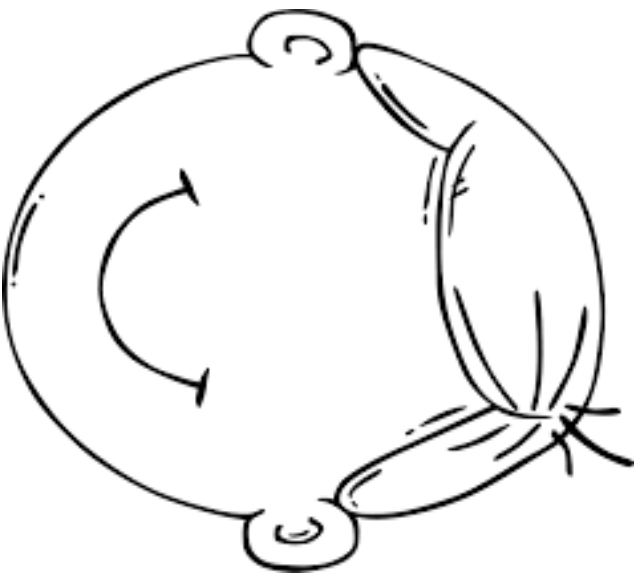
FAITH WITHOUT SEEING

- Use red glitter glue to decorate the hearts on Jesus' hands.

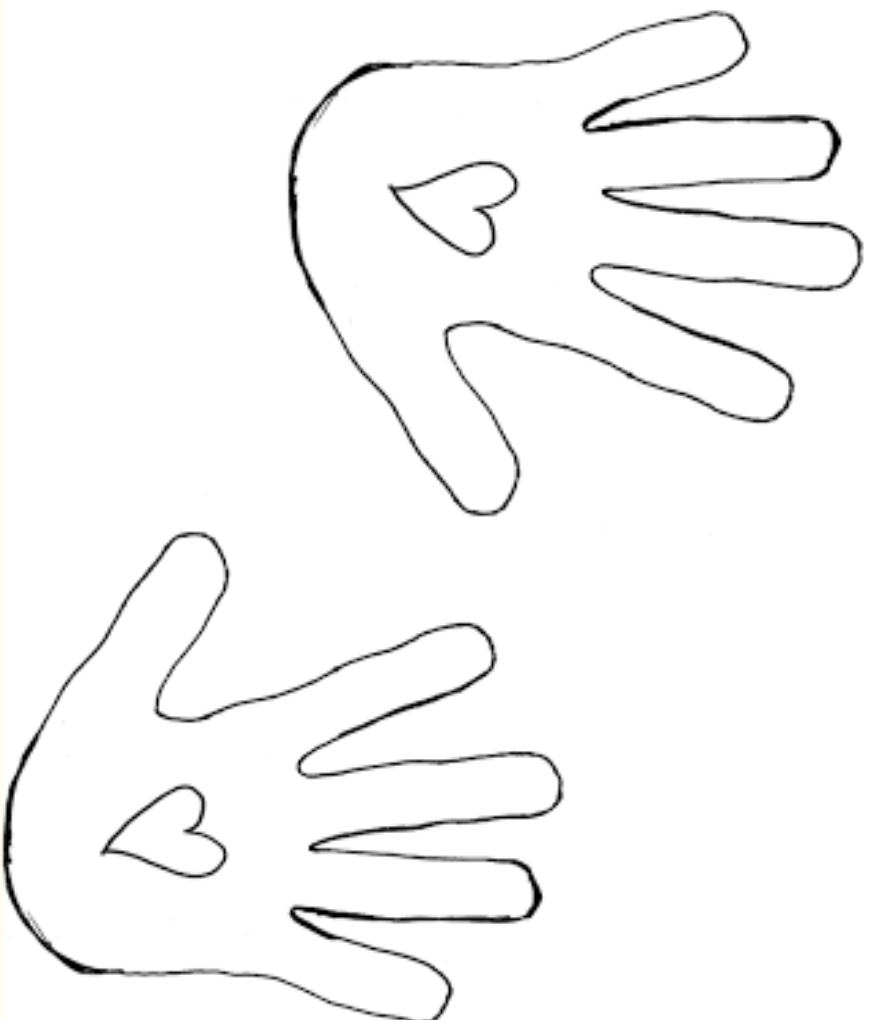


Thomas didn't believe Jesus was alive without seeing Him with his own eyes.
