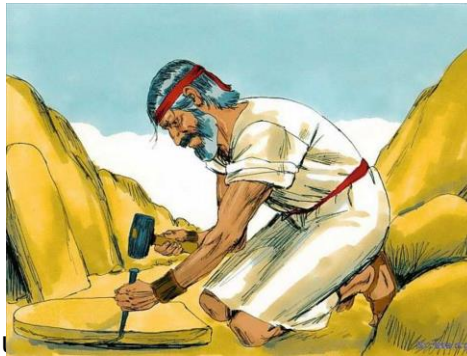

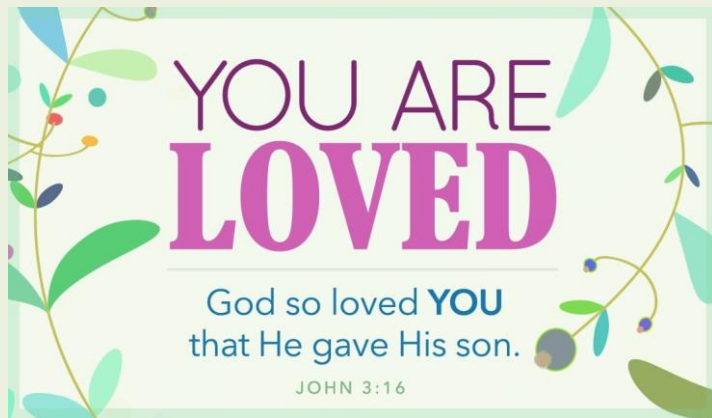

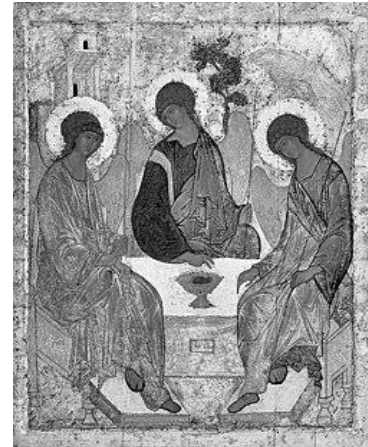


From the desk of the Parish Priest.

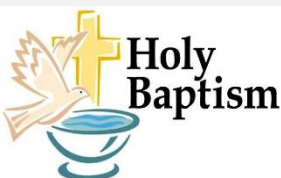
