NCPW is a national campaign that brings Australians together to promote the safety and wellbeing of children and young people. It provides an opportunity to raise awareness of child abuse and neglect, share valuable resources, amplify children's voices, and encourage practical actions that support families and communities, and help prevent harm before it occurs. This year National Child Protection Week is driving a stronger national focus on shifting conversations into meaningful action. Conversations can spark ideas, build understanding and encourage reflection.
