REFLECTION

In Luke 23:35–43, we hear the powerful story of Jesus on the cross. As others mocked Him, one of the criminals crucified beside Him turned to Jesus and said, “Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom.” Jesus replied, “Today you will be with me in paradise.” Even in His suffering, Jesus offered forgiveness, mercy, and hope.

This Gospel is read on the Feast of Christ the King, a celebration that reminds us that Jesus is not a king of power, wealth, or control, but a king of love, compassion, and sacrifice. His crown was made of thorns, and His throne was the cross. Yet from that place of pain, He showed us the depth of God's love for every person.

Recognizing Jesus as King of the Universe means choosing to follow His example in our daily lives. It means letting His love rule our hearts and guide our actions. When we forgive others, show kindness, stand up for what is right, and help those in need, we are living as citizens of His kingdom.

In a world where people often seek power and status, Jesus reminds us that true greatness is found in humility and love. Each day, we are invited to make Jesus our king, not just in words, but through the way we live and love others.
