The Lord says this: I am coming to gather the nations of every language. They shall come to witness my glory. I will give them a sign and send some of their survivors to the nations: to Tarshish, Put, Lud, Moshech, Rosh, Tubal, and Javan, to the distant islands that have never heard of me or seen my glory. They will proclaim my glory to the nations. As an offering to the Lord they will bring all your brothers, on horses, in chariots, in litters, on mules, on dromedaries, from all the nations to my holy mountain in Jerusalem, says the Lord, like Israelites bringing oblations in clean vessels to the Temple of the Lord. And of some of them I will make priests and Levites, says the Lord.

Responsorial Psalm Ps 116 Response: Go out to allt he world and tell the Good News Second Reading—Hebrews 12:5-7, 11-13

Have you forgotten that encouraging text in which you are addressed as sons? My son, when the Lord corrects you, do not treat it lightly; but do not get discouraged when he reprimands you. For the Lord trains the ones that he loves and he punishes all those that he acknowledges as his sons. Suffering is part of your training; God is treating you as his sons. Has there ever been any son whose father did not train him? Of course, any punishment is most painful at the time, and far from pleasant; but later, in those on whom it has been used, it bears fruit in peace and goodness. So hold up your limp arms and steady your trembling knees and

wrenched, it will grow strong again.

Gospel Acclamation:

'Then there will be weeping and grinding of teeth, when you see Abraham and Isaac and Jacob and all the prophets in the kingdom of God, and vourselves turned outside. And men from east and west, from north and south, will come to take their places at the feast in the kingdom of God.

'Yes, there are those now last who will be first, and those now first who will be last.'

Gospel Reflection - Luke 13: 22-30

My friends, today Jesus speaks of the narrow door. At first, it can sound confronting — "Many will try to enter and will not be able." But Jesus is not trying to frighten us. He's inviting us to reflect on how we are living our faith.

The narrow door isn't narrow because God wants to keep us out. It's narrow because we cannot pass through carrying everything. Pride, grudges, selfishness — they weigh us down. To walk through, we must travel light, with humility, with forgiveness, and with love.

And here's the Good News: that door is open to everyone. Jesus tells us people will come from east and west, north and south, and sit at the banquet of God's Kingdom. All are invited. So the question is simple: what am I holding on to that makes it harder to pass through that door? Perhaps a hurt I cannot let go of. perhaps a habit that draws me away from God, perhaps a busyness that leaves no space for prayer.

The Lord is asking us not just to know His name, but to live our faith with sincerity in our prayer, in our service, and in the way we love one another.

May we keep striving for that narrow door, trusting that Christ walks beside us, leading us into His Father's house. With every blessing, Fr Jerald


