Greetings from St Anne's Parish.

Dear family of grade four children,

Grade four is the year of the sacrament of First Communion (or Eucharist). All those eligible families please fill the enrolment form attached here. Enrolment is essential. The details like email and contact number have to be correct, and attach copy of baptism certificate if this is the first time you are joining the program at St. Anne's.

Our program details;

On weekends February 21/22 and Feb 28/Mar 1 will be the Masses where I receive the enrolment forms. Parents with child/ren for Communion needs to be present for either of these Masses with the completed enrolment forms. On March 11 (Wednesday) 6:30 pm, will be the Sacramental information evening for parents and child/ren and is held at St. Anne's church (address below). Families of non-Catholic schools also must attend this session. This session runs for an hour and half. At the end of this session workbooks will be distributed. (Parents who are unable attend this session must organise someone responsible to attend. This can't be someone who is already doing the program.) Parents needs to help your child complete the workbook. Mass attendance weekends are March 14/15, 21/22, 28/29, April 4/5, 11/12, 18/19, 25/26, May 2/3, 9/10, 16/17, 23/24, 30/31.

On or before May April 18/19 your child/ren must return their profile pages. On or before June 1st at return your child's workbook to respective schools, non-Catholic school students can drop off at the parish office or in the mailbox outside church or hand it to me when you come to the Mass. The workbooks will be examined and if not done properly it will be returned to you. If you need the workbook back, let us know after receiving the sacrament.

Celebration dates are June 13/14, 20/21, 27/28, Jul 18/19, at the church at any weekend Masses you choose. More information will be provided at the information evening. Your child will be able to receive sacrament only upon the successful completion of the program.

For Non- Catholic school children there will be additional program run by our volunteers which should be attended. Families will be contacted by the office.

Just a reminder, successful completion of the program means completing the above requirements and attending at least three weekend Masses (we are not expecting families for weekday Masse). Failure to complete these requirements means your child is not ready to receive the sacrament this year.
