MIGRANT & REFUGEE SUNDAY

Today we celebrate the 112th World Day of Migrants & Refugees. Every defenceless and vulnerable child matters to God, and we are called to remember their needs. Pope Leo chose this year's World Day of Migrants and Refugee's theme as 'Even Just One of These Children.' He reminds us that "Minors are the most vulnerable group within the global movements of migration." Their traumas include being forced to leave their homeland, losing family members to violence, being separated from family members, trafficking, exploitation and other atrocities. Their many vulnerabilities call for an urgent response...Pope Leo challenges Christian communities to become places of welcome, healing and dignity, where, "every boy and every girl is respected and valued in his or her own cultural identity".
