Tuesday 6 August—The Transfiguration of the Lord.

Thursday 8 August—St Mary of the Cross, virgin. Mary MacKillop was born in Melbourne in 1842. Died in Sydney in 1909. Took the religious name of Mary of the Cross. Responding to the isolation of colonial families, she pioneered a new form of religious life to provide education for their children. She and her sisters shared the life of the poor and the itinerant, offering special care to destitute women and children. Remembered for her eagerness to discover God's will in all things, for her charity in the face of calumny, and for her abiding trust in God's providence.

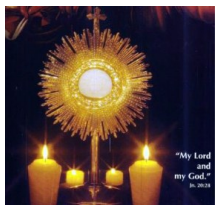

Natural Fertility Awareness Week (19-25 August) promotes an alternative, healthy option to family planning compared with chemical and other contraceptive devices.

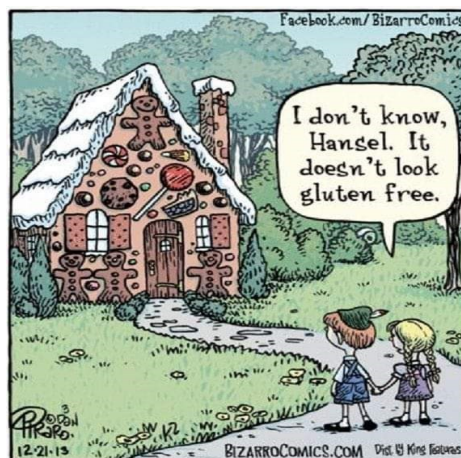
