SECOND READING: A reading from the first letter of Paul to the Corinthians. 1:1-3 GOSPEL ACCLAMATION: The Word of God became flesh and dwelt among us. He enabled those who accepted him to become children of God. GOSPEL: JOHN 1:29-34 The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world.
